Prince / Princess Program Information

Welcome to the Arkansas State Fair Princess and Prince Mentoring Program! We are excited to have you as a part of our State Fair Pageant Competition that will be held at the Arkansas Building located on the Arkansas State Fairgrounds.

The goal of our program is to introduce young people across our great state to the Arkansas State Fair Organization. Each year the ASF awards over \$100,000 in scholarships, cash prizes, and sponsored gifts.

The ASF Prince/Princess will attend a party hosted by the current ASF Royalty, receive a crown and sash, a t-shirt, enjoy snacks and games, rehearsal, and will accompany the Contestant on-stage during the competition. If the Contestant you are accompanying is chosen to return for the finals held on Saturday night, you will return for the event. Instructions for Saturday night will be discussed at the Fair Party.

Each Prince/Princess is allowed to bring one parent or guardian to the Fair Party that will begin at 1:00. Check-in will begin at 12:00 at the back door of the Arkansas Building.

Princess is required to wear a tux or suit for the evening performance.
Princess is required to wear a formal dress of choice.

Prince/Princess will also be sent a video to learn a routine that will be performed during the competition. Rehearsal will also be held during the fair party.

Prince/Princess will dress in the area designated for the evening performance.

You will need to be dressed and ready to go and in your assigned seat at 5:00.

If your Contestant is chosen to return on Saturday for the finals, you will return also.

Each child participating will receive 3 admission tickets and 1 parking pass which will be mailed to the address listed above.
